

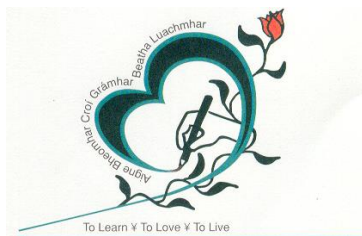
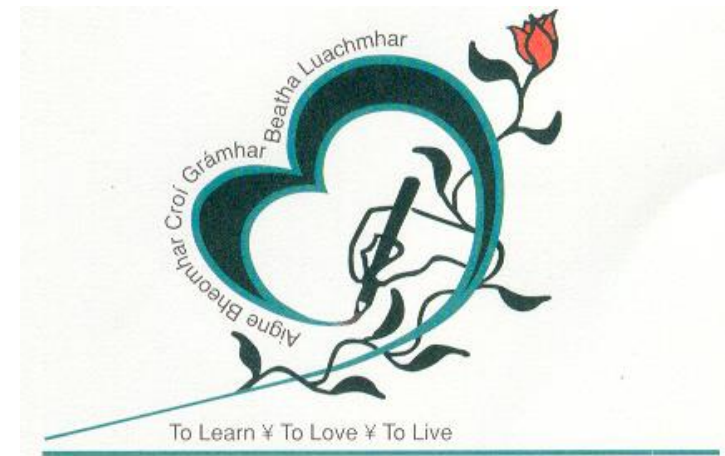

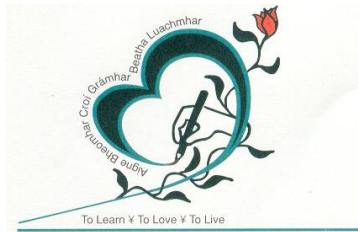

Serious Offences



Parents/Guardians will be contacted regarding the following:

- Refusal to do what a staff member asks.
- Bad /violent language.
- Jeering/name calling/bullying.
- Physical violence/intimidation of students or staff.
- Smoking ANYWHERE on the school grounds or environs.
- Abuse of drugs or any other substance.
- Stealing or damaging school property.
- Immoral sexual comments or actions.
- Refusal to co-operate with mobile phone.

Code of Discipline (order of procedure)

Information for Parents/Guardians

How you can help with School Systems and Programmes

Attendance and Timekeeping

Good attendance and timekeeping are expected. A written explanation or phone call is required to explain absence or late arrival.

- Students who use public transport or arrive by escorted bus, access school premises at 8.35 am.
- Breakfast club - cereal, toast and juice available each morning from 08.35 to 08.50.
- All JC students escorted to classrooms.
- All LCA students escorted to classrooms.

- All post primary students for minibus transport leave school at 2.15 pm.
- Parents/guardians who come to the school must report to reception.

School Work

- School work is arranged at levels suited to the needs of the students.
- Regular monthly assessments and end of term test in each class.
- Positive work attitudes are expected.
- Parents are encouraged to contact the school with any queries or suggestions.

Homework

- Each student will have a Homework Journal.
- Parents are requested to help with homework.
- Parents must ensure that they check the student's homework before signing the journal each day.



School Books and Materials

- All books, materials, photocopying are supplied by the school.
- Parents are requested to make a contribution towards the annual costs.
- Post Primary €120/€145.



Lunch

- Coláiste Eoin encourages good nutrition.
- Healthy lunches are provided free of charge. If supplementing lunch students are expected to bring healthy food to school, sandwiches, fruit, non fizzy drinks etc.

Sport

- Sport is timetabled throughout the week for 1st&2nd Years. 3rd, 5th& 6th Years PE is Friday afternoon
- Students should have suitable sports gear.



Football: Boots, t-shirt, shorts/tracksuit bottoms.

Basketball: Runners, t-shirt, shorts/tracksuit bottoms.

Swimming: 1st & 2nd years, togs and towel.

Personal Issues

- Cleanliness and neat dress expected. Uniforms (navy tracksuit and white polo shirt are compulsory.
- Smoking is strictly forbidden in or around the school premises.
- No cigarettes or lighters to be brought to school.
- No chewing gum (because of damage to carpets, floors, furniture).
- Mobile phones and hand held game consoles cannot be used on the school premises or on school buses.
- Mobile phones must be handed in to class teacher at the start of the day. Phones will be returned at home time.

Main School Rules For Students



(For Classroom, Yard, Sports field, travelling to and from school)

- Good timekeeping always expected
- Be prepared:
 - (a) Homework completed and journal signed
 - (b) Books, copies, pens, pencil, ruler
 - (c) Lunch / Sports gear.
- Show respect towards all staff, Principal, Deputy Principal, Coordinators, Teachers, Classroom Assistants, Caretakers and Cleaning Staff.
- Do what you are asked by all staff
- Wait for the right time to talk to staff member
- Observe specific classroom/teacher rules and safety instructions.
- Keep unhelpful hands, feet, objects and comments to yourself
- Mobile phones to be handed to class teacher at start of day and returned at home time. No hand held games allowed.
- **No** chewing gum.
- Students must ask for permission to leave their seats at all times, e.g. to leave the room, go to the toilet, etc.
- Responsible behaviour when travelling to and from school on buses.
- Support classmates and other students in refusing to tolerate bullying.
- Baseball hats / hoodies not to be worn on the school premises.
